<p>Approval of minutes</p> <p>Meeting purpose</p> <p>Current situation</p> <p>Community Health Focus - Population and sample characteristics</p>	<p>Work to collaboratively develop care coordination through an integrative model.</p> <p>Healthcare is presently rendered in a fragmented model. Aspects of healthcare reform will address care coordination, quality of care, and access to care. As a community we need to address current disparities in health and prepare for a future healthcare model.</p> <p>An earmark request has been made for this legislative session which will accelerate the infrastructure development of the Life Care Coordination model. Each community partner offers services which are an integral part of this model.</p> <p>City of Titusville There is a discrepancy between the needs of the individual and the perceived needs from the healthcare provider's viewpoint. Need to determine and develop communication in order for right services</p>	<p>Develop communication model to connect all providers.</p> <p>Earmark request pending.</p> <p>Healthcare is community-based and local. Quality of care improves as communication between healthcare provider and individual improves.</p> <p>Life care coordination model use of community navigator, Call Center, and the Community Health partnership will assist in addressing these two issues.</p>

Interventions	<p>to be provided to the person at the time of need.</p> <p>Partnership began discussing potential models that would enhance intra-agency communication.</p> <p>Brevard 211 has an extensive database of community needs registered with them during the last two years. This database provides a broad view of the situations requiring attention with our community.</p> <p>City of Titusville suggested that intra-agency communication can use same model and structure as the Emergency Response Network. Would need to identify what the service support care required and identify a key agency to coordinate each service.</p>	Discuss potential model at next meeting.
